Member Pledge

Commitment:

Due to the unique nature of PCC, the need for the commitment of our members is vital to the success of our group. It truly takes each person working together each week to operate the co-op. Therefore, we ask all members to commit to the following:

- I agree to meet deadlines, work with my partner to facilitate our class, be prepared to facilitate my class, and come each week with the goal of engaging my students and with the desire to see them succeed.
- I agree to read and abide by the PCC Policies and Procedures.
- I understand that I need to arrive promptly, attend opening assembly on-time, obtain all required curriculum and supplies, and be responsible for any PCC curriculum or materials in my care.
- I understand that the conduct and behavior of my children are my responsibility and that I need to take a proactive approach to their conduct while on campus and with their facilitators. I understand that I am responsible for my child(ren) and if a problem arises, I will take the initiative to work with the facilitator(s) or other involved members to see that the situation is resolved.
- I commit to fulfilling my duties in the co-op for the entire school year, with the understanding that when a team member leaves it causes not only a disruption to the classes but additional time and work load to those tasked to replace the member.
- I understand that payment for registration, classes, and supply fees are non-refundable should I decide to withdraw or in extreme cases asked to be dismissed from PCC.

Conduct:

Our main focus is to glorify the Lord and serve each other. In order to do this we need to be mindful that this is a cooperative. We are all volunteers working together for the benefit of our children and each other. This takes a willingness to serve each other and a great amount of love and grace for one another.

In the spirit of wanting the co-op to be led and directed by the Lord and be a blessing to all, please prayerfully consider any complaints and comments. Let's not give the enemy room to cause division. If you are unhappy with something, please pray about it first. If it is still an issue, please come to the appropriate person, in love, and discuss the situation with them and not others.

- I will maintain a testimony that reflects the will and desire of my Lord Jesus Christ in both conduct and attitude. I will seek unity in relationships and resolve to deal positively with conflicts considering the value of all those around me by avoiding gossip or slander.
- If not in agreement with something done or said, I will give myself a "cooling off period" to pray and then seek out the appropriate person with grace and with the desire for peace and reconciliation.
- I will support the policies and procedures of the co-op and if not in agreement I will look to offer solutions not complaints.
- I understand that a co-op can be a dynamic situation where changes may need to occur which will require flexibility and a heart to serve.
